

# **THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BROCK**

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 2384-2011-PP**

### **A BY-LAW FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING BILLIARD, POOL AND BAGATELLE TABLES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF BROCK**

---

**WHEREAS** pursuant to the provisions of Part IV of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, as amended, the Council of the Township of the Brock may provide for a system of licences with respect to businesses;


**AND WHEREAS** Section 391 of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, as amended, authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges for services or activities provided or done by them;


**NOW THEREFORE** THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BROCK ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Proprietary club" means all clubs other than those in which the use of any such table is only incidental to the main objects of the club;
2. That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons for hire or gain, nor for any proprietary club, directly or indirectly, to keep or have in his or their or its possession or on his or their or its premises any billiard, pool or bagatelle tables in a place of public entertainment whether such billiard, pool or bagatelle table or tables is or are used or not, without having first obtained a licence to keep or have such billiard, pool or bagatelle tables as hereinafter provided.
3. The sum to be paid as a licence aforesaid shall be as follows:
  - (a) One billiard, pool or bagatelle table - \$50.00 per annum.
  - (b) For each additional table, making more than one billiard, pool or bagatelle table on the same premises - the sum of \$25.00 per annum.
4. Any person or proprietary club desiring a licence as aforesaid shall make application to the Council of the Township, and if said application is granted by the said Council, then the Treasurer of the Corporation is hereby authorized to issue the said licence on payment to the said Treasurer of the sum as above specified.
5. That the licence fee payable for billiard, pool or bagatelle tables herein provided shall be due on the first day of March, payable in advance, and such amounts shall be paid annually for renewal of such licence on or before the first day of March, respectively, in each and every year following the first issue of any such licence, and shall have force and effect only so long as such annual licence fee has been paid in advance from year to year.
6. That every billiard, pool or bagatelle table licensed under this by-law shall be closed by and not allowed to be used after the hour of eleven o'clock in the afternoon and not before the hour of nine o'clock in the forenoon of the day on Monday to Saturday, inclusive. That every billiard, pool or bagatelle table so licensed under this by-law shall be closed by and not allowed to be used after the hour of eleven o'clock in the afternoon and not before the hour of twelve o'clock noon on Sunday.
7. That if any person or persons who shall have obtained a licence under this by-law allow any gaming either for money or other equivalent in connection with the billiard, pool or bagatelle table or tables so licensed, he or they shall absolutely forfeit such licence.
8. No person or persons having been granted a licence under this by-law shall allow any person or persons under sixteen years of age, unless accompanied by an adult, to play on or use said billiard, pool or bagatelle tables.
9. No person or persons under sixteen years of age, unless accompanied by an adult, shall play on or use the said licensed billiard, pool or bagatelle tables.


10. The hours of time referred to in this by-law shall be in accordance with Eastern Standard Time or Daylight Saving Time in effect from time to time in the Province of Ontario.
11. Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and shall, upon conviction, be liable to a penalty as prescribed by the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, chapter P.33.
12. Each day that a person, persons or company contravenes any provisions of this by-law constitutes a separate offence.
13. Every fine imposed is recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33, as amended.
14. That By-law Number 2017-2006-PP be and the same is hereby repealed.
15. That this By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its passage.


