Duties may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Respond to winter event phone calls received at any time, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays, on an on-call as needed basis
- Safely operate sidewalk machines/tractors on sidewalks and walkways
- Shovel snow as needed in tight locations where machines are not able to access
- Maintain communication with the Supervisor of Operations and Public Works staff on any pertinent information relating to plowing, or winter operations
- Accurately input daily timesheets
- Compiling a daily notes or journal as needed pertaining to work completed of identified hazards
- Ability to arrive to work in challenging weather conditions
- Provide basic daily maintenance on equipment used
- Other duties as assigned

## Qualifications:

- Must have a valid and clean class G driver's license
- Previous experience in operating snow removal equipment, specifically light duty agricultural tractors with three-point hitch and plow attachments, would be considered an asset
- Ability to be on-call from November 2024 April 2024
