SUMMER POSITIONS—2019

The Township of Brock is seeking applications for the following positions:

1. Senior Camp Counsellors: June 25 – August 23 (40 hr/week)

The successful applicants will assist the Recreation and Leisure Coordinator in the planning and delivery of a summer day camp program inclusive of purchasing supplies, scheduling and planning activities for participants, and leading/participating in the day camp operation. Applicants must supply transportation, act as a positive role model for camp participants and be well organized and enthusiastic. Applicants selected must have standard first-aid and CPR-C and a current criminal reference check. These documents must be provided well in advance of the first day of employment.

2. Camp Counsellors: June 25 – August 23 (40 hr/week)

The successful applicants will, upon direction from the Recreation and Leisure Coordinator and Senior Camp Counsellor, assist in the daily operation of the summer day camp by leading activities for camp participants. Applicants must supply transportation, act as a positive role model for camp participants and be well organized and enthusiastic. Applicants selected must have standard first-aid and CPR-C and a current criminal reference check. These documents must be provided well in advance of the first day of employment.

3. Tourist Information Officer: May 16 – August 23 (40 hr/week)

The successful applicant will collect and submit all boat launch fees at the Beaverton Harbour, distribute tourist information to area visitors, answer public inquiries, and assist community groups with special events as required. Daily general cleaning and maintenance of the harbour office, trails kiosk, harbour pier and harbour beach area is a must. Applicants must be customer-service oriented, knowledgeable of the area, and willing to work independently. The position requires the ability to work all weekends.

These positions are available only to those who will be continuing their post-secondary education in the fall of 2019.
